Invitation of proposals for innovative and futuristic waste solutions to handle the urban waste

Background

Bidhannagar, the most important satellite town of the city of Kolkata is situated on the eastern edge of the city. Bidhannagar Municipal Corporation (BMC) is the youngest Municipal Corporation constituted under the WBMA, 1993 and the West Bengal Panchayat Act, 1973 in West Bengal on 7th May 2015. The BMC geographically spread with One (1) Head office at Bidhannagar, Six (6) Borough offices and Forty One (41) ward offices across the jurisdiction of the BMC boundary under the aegis of Department Municipal Affairs & Urban Development, Government of West Bengal. The boundary of BMC covers around 60.5 Sq. Km. of total Kolkata Metropolitan Area of 1886.67 Sq. Km. catering services to 6.5 lakhs population which is 1.27% of Kolkata Metropolitan Area population and 0.68% of State population covering approximately 1.47 lakhs households.

BMC, which handles about 350 MT of waste on a daily basis, presently undertakes the entire work of waste management from door to door collection, transportation, compaction to final disposal through its own manpower resources, vehicles and equipment. For effective implementation of SWM Rules 2016, BMC is going to introduce the system of waste segregation at source, broadly into wet and dry waste, for which the modalities are being worked out.

To help to cut down on the amount of waste and to give effect to the principal of 3 R's (Reduce, Reuse and Recycle), BMC seeks proposals for innovative and futuristic waste solutions to handle the process of disposed of urban waste.

Requirement

Companies working in area of Waste Management need to provide presentation and preferably demonstrate Waste Management model before the Task force of BMC. Any company interested for same may apply through the format available in Annexure.
